SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Musicians Institute and Carvin Guitar Corporation have created the Carvin Guitar Scholarship to assist advanced guitarists with their educational development. The scholarship details and criteria are as follows:

- Available to international students and US citizens.
- Scholarship applicants must have submitted the Application for Admissions by the scholarship application deadline and must be entering the program for the first time.
- May only be applied to the Associate of Arts in Performance (Guitar) Program. Certificate and Encore programs are not eligible.
- The total scholarship amount will be divided into two awards of \$1000 each and credited toward the first two quarters tuition as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.
- Scholarships are non-transferable, and may not be applied to any person, program or start date other than the one for which it was awarded.
- Award recipients will be notified one to two weeks after the final application deadline.

and the deadline for Fall 2010 is September 13th 2010**
