

# Development Scholarship Application



**Musicians Institute offers the MI Development Scholarship in order to encourage the educational development of musicians and music industry professionals. The scholarship requirements and details are as follows:**

- Available to US citizens and permanent residents only.
- Scholarship applicants must have submitted Application for Admissions by scholarship due date and must be entering the program for the first time.
- Based on demonstrated financial need as well as academic history.
- May be applied to any Musicians Institute Certificate or Degree program (Encore is not eligible).
- The total scholarship amount (minimum \$1000.00) will be divided by the total number of quarters in the particular program and credited toward each quarter's tuition in equal amounts for as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.
- Scholarships are non-transferable, and may not be applied to any person, program, or start date other than the one for which it was originally awarded.

**Scholarship application deadlines:**

- For Summer 2009 (Audio Engineering only), the due date is May 25<sup>th</sup> 2009
- For Fall 2009, the due date is August 10<sup>th</sup> 2009
- For Winter 2010 (Audio Engineering only), the due date is November 23<sup>rd</sup> 2009
- For Spring 2010, the due date is February 8<sup>th</sup> 2010

**To be eligible for the MI Development Scholarship, an application for enrollment to MI must be on file by the appropriate due date. Award recipients will be notified one to two weeks following the application due date.**

- A 250-word essay explaining why you should be considered for the MI Development Scholarship. You may include your musical background, aspirations, financial situation, or any other factors that you consider relevant.
- A copy of your official high school or college transcript (for college transcripts, a minimum of 24 semester units or 36 quarter credits is required).
- A copy of your tax return or other income verification for the previous year (if 21 years of age or younger, a copy of parents' tax return is also required).
