SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Musicians Institute offers the MI Development Scholarship in order to encourage the educational development of musicians and music industry professionals. The scholarship requirements and details are as follows:

- Available to US citizens and permanent residents only.
- Complete application must be received by scholarship due date and must be entering the program for the first time.
- Incomplete applications will not be forwarded to the scholarship committee.
- Based on demonstrated financial need as well as academic history.
- May be applied to any Musicians Institute Certificate or Degree program (Encore is not eligible).
- The total scholarship amount (minimum \$1,000.00) will be divided by the total number of quarters in the particular program and credited toward each quarter's tuition in equal amounts for as long as the student maintains satisfactory academic progress.
- Scholarships are non-transferable, and may not be applied to any person, program, or start date other than the one for which it was originally awarded.

Scholarship application deadlines:

For Winter 2012 (Audio Engineering & Music Business Only) the due date is
November 11, 2011

For Spring 2012, the due date is
February 24, 2012

To be eligible for the MI Development Scholarship, an application for enrollment to MI must be on file by the appropriate due date. Award recipients will be notified one to two weeks following the application due date.

- A copy of your official high school or college transcript (for college transcripts, a minimum of 24 semester units or 36 quarter credits is required).
- A copy of your tax return or other income verification for the previous year (if 21 years of age or younger, a copy of parents' tax return is also required).
