Dear Musicians Institute Community Member,

As you are likely aware, the citizens of the State of California voted on November 8th to legalize the recreational use of marijuana within the State. Although this is to become the law of the State in the near future, marijuana remains illegal under federal law. As an educational institution, Musicians Institute is required to comply with all federal laws irrespective of the existence of competing or opposing state laws.

In short, this means that the use, possession, sale, or distribution of Marijuana remains prohibited on the Musicians Institute Campus, at the Residence Halls, and at any and all Musician Institute-sponsored or Musicians Institute-related activity.
